IMPORTANT NOTES.

Warm up will be available for WA1500 and Open matches but not the 48 and 60 round matches.

Scoring will be carried out by allocated Judges, not by competitors. Chronographing will be conducted.

Competitors will be squadded for time slots in 48 round, 60 round and WA1500 matches. The competitor will decide which match they shoot in each allocated time slot. Score sheets and target stickers will be handed out at Gun Check. It is the competitor's responsibility to hand the correct Score Sheet to the Range Officer on the line and attach correct match stickers to target. No correspondence will be entered into for incorrect score sheet or labelling. Squadding will be emailed or posted out prior to competition.

If you are sharing pistols in any match you will need to complete the section on the entry clearly, indicating which match/s you are sharing and with whom.
