**Hosted by Sporting Shooters Pistol Club at Merriganowry Range, Theole Road, via Cowra.**

**CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:**

All competitors MUST be members of ACTPA or some other State body affiliated with Pistol Australia. No visitor's licence is required for the ACT. All visiting competitors to the ACT with current target pistol licence in their own state have reciprocal rights while competing in the ACT. Permits or licenses will be checked.

Matches will be conducted in accordance with the current Pistol Australia metallic Silhouette Rules. Competitors are strongly encouraged to become familiar with these rules. No full metal-jacketed ammunition is allowed except for the revolver category only.

Grading cards must be presented. Ungraded competitors will be graded according to scores shot on the day.

Competitors should be ready prior to squadded detail and will be required to assist with range duties as allocated. Line officers will be allocated and one of their responsibilities will be to check that ram targets are properly set at the end of each target resetting sequence. That is, for big bore targets the rams' feet must be set up against the provided foot stop. No targets will be awarded if not knocked down in accordance with current Pistol Australia rules.

Competitors or their spotter will be required to reset and paint targets. Targets (particularly rams) can be heavy. Ensure that your target setter is capable of resetting them. Use care when lifting targets. It is recommended that gloves be worn when setting targets. Suitable footwear and clothing must be worn on the range. Children must be under direct supervision at all times.

Shoot off targets will be: Revolver, Production and Unlimited categories - Half scale Turkey, Pig, Chicken, Pig, Turkey at 200 metres. Standing - Full size Turkeys at 150 metres. Unlimited Standing half size Turkeys at 150m.

Graded and Top Gun trophies will be awarded in each category plus Perpetual trophies for 5 match aggregates in Open, Ladies and Junior.

Practice and sighting will be available on Thursday. Limited refreshments will be available over the three days. CMPC will provide a Saturday night dinner at the club house on the range.
