**CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:**

The Competition will be held over three days. Due to the unusual squadding requirements people wishing to shoot 4 or more matches **must be available for the three days.**

**All competitors must be capitated with Pistol Australia and carry a current state association membership card. Firearms licenses/permits will be checked at Registration.**

Shooters or their spotters will be required to reset and paint targets.

Shooting will commence at 9:00 am on Saturday and Sunday. Shooters should be ready 10 minutes before their squadded relay. Commencement time on Friday will depend on the number of entries and will be notified on the squadding form.

The range will be available for practice on Thursday prior to the competition. Gun check and registration will open on Thursday afternoon and ONE HOUR before shooting commences on the days of the competition. Grading cards will be collected at registration. Pistol Licenses will be checked.

**CATERING FACILITIES:** Kiosk will be available on all days.  
Dinner will be provided Sat. night at \$15 per person.

**The range is situated on natural ground and all the people attending assume responsibility for their own safe movement around the range.**

**TIED SCORES:** These will be decided as follows:  
First place in each category by cumulative shoot off.  
Grade ties will be decided by reverse animal count, if still equal then by shoot off.  
Tied match aggregates will be decided by count-back of total number of rams etc., if still equal then a shoot off consisting of 5 shots per category will be used to decide.

Shoot off targets will be:  
Smallbore Revolver, Production, - full size Turkey, Pig, Chicken, Pig, Turkey at 100 metres  
Unlimited – 1/5 scale Turkey, Pig, Turkey, Pig, Turkey at 100 metres  
Standing – full size Turkeys at 75 metres  
Field Pistol Full size Turkeys at 75 metres

**ACCOMMODATION:** Early bookings with Hotels/Motels in Cowra is advised.

**CAMPING FACILITIES** are available at the range at a cost of \$15 per person.  
Water is from a rainwater tank, so you may wish to bring your own drinking water.
