### PROGRAM

14 September – Small Bore & Field Pistol practice. 15-17 September – Small Bore & Field Pistol competition.  
Small Bore & Field Pistol Awards following completion of shooting on 17 September.  
18 September – Big Bore practice. 19-21 September – Big Bore competition.  
Big Bore Awards following the completion of Shooting on 21 September.

### OPENING CEREMONY:

The Opening Ceremony will be held at the end of competition on Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> September 2024.

**LICENCING OF PISTOLS:** All visiting shooters to NSW with current target pistol licenses in their own State have reciprocal rights while competing in NSW. Permits or licenses will be checked.

**CATERING:** Canteen facilities will be available on all Competition days.

### ACCOMMODATION:

Camping facilities, including hot showers are available at the range at a cost of \$15.00 per person for each Championship or \$30 for both.

### AWARDS:

Pistol Australia will provide the following awards:

- i. Perpetual Trophies:**  
Top Gun in each category.  
Two Match Field Pistol Aggregate in Open, Women's and Junior Individual and Team categories.  
Four Match Small Bore & Big Bore Aggregate in Open, Women's and Junior Individual and Team categories.
- ii. Plaques:**  
1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in Small Bore & Big Bore Open, Women's and Junior Four Match Aggregate.  
1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in Field Pistol Open, Women's and Junior Two Match Aggregate.  
1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in each category.
- iii. Brassards:**  
1<sup>st</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> in each category.
- iv. Team Medals:**  
1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Small Bore Four Match Aggregate – Open, Women's and Junior categories.  
1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Field Pistol Two Match Aggregate – Open, Women's and Junior categories.  
1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Big Bore Open in each category – Production, Revolver, Standing and Unlimited categories.  
1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> Big Bore Four Match Aggregate – Women's and Junior categories.

### GRADE TROPHIES:

The Narrabri Pistol Club Inc. will provide grade trophies.

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. All resident Australian competitors must be current financial members of Pistol Australia.
2. The Championships will be held over two series of 3 days under IMSSU Rules as adopted by Pistol Australia. Big Bore Unlimited Full-Scale category will be held as a side match. Persons entering more than four (4) matches must be available for the three days of the relevant competition.
3. Shooting mats will not be supplied. Please bring your own mat.
4. Gun Checks will be supervised by the Jury and will commence at 4.00pm on Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> September; 4.00pm Wednesday 18 September and one (1) hour prior to commencement of competition on other days.
5. All Competitors should be graded, and grading cards will be collected at Registration.
6. Shooters should be ready at least 10 minutes before their squadded relay.
7. Shooting will commence at 8.00am each day unless advised otherwise.
8. Shooters or their spotters will be required to stand and paint the targets. Target setters are advised to check the weight of the targets before lifting to ensure weights are within their physical capabilities; and that targets are lifted in the correct manner. It is recommended that gloves be worn when setting targets. A vehicle will be provided for transport to Big Bore turkeys and rams.
9. Only suitable footwear and clothing that comply with Pistol Australia/NSWAPA and Narrabri PC guidelines are permitted. Offensive clothing, singlets, crop tops or garments with loose fitting necks etc. are not permitted.
10. Qualified or suitably experienced persons will accept range duties where indicated in their squadding details.
11. Teams – Each State / Territory is eligible to enter the following teams:
  - Small Bore** – Two (2) person Four Match Aggregate in Open, Women's and Junior categories.
  - Field Pistol** – Two (2) person Two Match Aggregate in Open, Women's and Junior categories.
  - Big Bore** – Open - two (2) person Team in each category – Production, Revolver, Standing and Unlimited.  
Women's & Junior categories - two (2) person Four Match Aggregate Team.
12. Tied scores will be determined in the following manner:
  - (a) First, second & third place off gun in each category must be decided by shoot-off if scores are equal. Further Ties in Top 10 will be decided by countback. If identical then by shoot-off.
  - (b) Four Match & Two Match Individual Aggregate ties will be decided by reverse animal countback. In the event of a perfect equality, the concerned competitors will be declared of equal merit.
  - (c) Team Aggregates will be decided by reverse animal count back. If the animal count is equal, the Team having the best individual aggregate will win.
  - (d) Ties for first, second, and third places in grades will be decided by reverse count and then by shoot-off if still equal.
  - (e) Shoot-off sequence will be as follows:
  - (f) Field Pistol – Production Sight & PAS – ½ scale turkeys at 75m.
  - (g) Small Bore – Standing – ¾ scale turkeys at 75m; Revolver & Production - ¾ scale turkey, pig, chicken, pig turkey at 100m. Unlimited - ½ scale pig, turkey, ram, turkey, pig at 100m.
  - (h) Big Bore – Standing – full scale turkeys at 150m; Revolver & Production – ½ scale turkey, pig, chicken, pig, turkey at 200m; Unlimited and Full Scale Unlimited – ½ scale pig, chicken, pig, chicken, pig at 200m.
  - (i) Shoot-offs will be in five shot strings and will be exhaustive.
13. The range will be open for practice for Small Bore & Field Pistol - Saturday 14/09/24 from 10.00am – 4.00pm & Big Bore Wednesday 18/09/24 from 10.00am - 4.00pm.
14. Full jacketed ammunition allowed in revolver only.
15. The competition will be conducted using the relay system and only the daily start time will be given.
16. Pistol licences/permits will be checked at gun check. Licences being renewed will require proof of application.
