### **OPENING CEREMONY:**

The Opening Ceremony will be held at the end of competition on Friday 4<sup>th</sup> March 2022.

### **LICENCING OF PISTOLS:**

All visiting shooters to NSW with current target pistol licenses in their own State have reciprocal rights while competing in NSW. Permits/licenses will be checked.

### **CATERING:**

Canteen facilities will be available on Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

**DINNER:** A dinner will be held at the Narrabri RSL Club at 6.30 for 7.00pm on Saturday 5<sup>th</sup> March

### **ACCOMMODATION:**

Camping facilities are available at the range at a cost of \$15.00 per person for the Championships.

### **AWARDS:**

Pistol Australia will provide the following awards:

#### **i. Perpetual Trophies:**

Top Gun in each category.

Four Match Small Bore Aggregate in Open, Women's and Junior Individual and Team events.

Two Match Field Pistol Aggregate in Open, Women's and Junior Individual and Teams events.

#### **ii. Plaques:**

1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in Four Match Aggregate Small Bore Open, Women's and Junior events.

1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in Two Match Aggregate Field Pistol Open, Women's and Junior events.

1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in each category.

#### **iii. Brassards:**

1<sup>st</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> in each category.

#### **iv. Team Medals:**

1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Four Match Aggregate Small Bore Open, Women's and Junior events.

1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Two Match Aggregate Field Pistol Open, Women's and Junior events.

### **GRADE TROPHIES:**

Narrabri Pistol Club will provide grade trophies for the top three (3) places in each grade.

**PRACTICE:** The range will be open for practice from 9.00am – 5.00pm on Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> and 9.00am – 4.00pm on Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2022

**MEMORABILIA:** A sample shirt and cap will be on display and orders taken at the Championships

**REQUESTS:** Sharing pistols, spotting, back to back squadding etc. will be considered in order of receipt of entries.

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. All resident Australian competitors must be a current financial member of Pistol Australia.
2. The Championships will be held over 3 days under IMSSU Rules as adopted by Pistol Australia. Persons entering more than four (4) matches must be available for the 3 days.
3. All entries with accompanying fees must be received by 15 February 2022. The signing of the entry form by the competitor and the club official is a declaration attesting to the correctness of the information contained in the entry form.
4. Gun Checks will be supervised by a member of the Jury and will commence at 4.00pm on Practice Day, Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2022 and also one (1) hour prior to competition on other days.
5. All Competitors should be graded and Grading cards and Firearm Licences/Permits will be requested at Registration.
6. Shooters should be ready at least 10 minutes before their squadded relay.
7. Shooting will commence at 9.00am each day unless advised otherwise.
8. Shooters or their spotters will be required to stand and paint the targets.
9. Appropriate clothing and footwear must be worn on the range.
10. Qualified or suitably experienced persons will accept range duties where indicated in their squadding details.
11. Each State / Territory is eligible to enter the following teams:
  - (a) Two (2) person Four Match Aggregate for Small Bore in Open, Women's & Junior categories.
  - (b) Two (2) person Two Match Aggregate for Field Pistol in Open, Women's & Junior categories.
12. Tied scores will be determined in the following manner:
  - (a) The first three (3) places in each category must be decided by shoot-off if scores are equal;
  - (b) Four Match and Two Match Individual and Team Aggregates decided by reverse count back i.e. total number of rams, then total number of turkeys etc. If scores are still equal the tie will be broken by a shoot-off of five (5) shots per category;
  - (c) Ties for first, second and third places in grades will be decided by reverse count and then by shoot-off if still equal;
  - (d) Shoot-off sequence will be: Field Pistol - Production Sight and Production Any Sight;  
Small Bore - Standing, Revolver Production and Unlimited. Where a competitor is involved in more than one shoot-off in the same category, the first score will count for both shoot-offs.
  - (e) Shoot-off targets will be as follows:
    - i. Small Bore Standing – 3/8 scale turkeys at 75m
    - ii. Field Pistol Production Sights – ½ scale turkeys at 75m
    - iii. Field Pistol Any Sights – ½ scale turkeys at 75m
    - iv. SB Production and Revolver – 3/8 scale turkey, pig, chicken, pig, turkey at 100m.
    - v. SB Unlimited – 1/5 scale pig, turkey, ram, turkey, pig at 100m.
    - vi. Shoot offs will be in five shot strings and will be exhaustive.
13. The competition will be conducted using the relay system and only the daily start time will be given.
14. **IMPORTANT NOTE:** By entering this competition, you acknowledge that all results will be published on the Narrabri Pistol Club, NSWAPA, SA or PA websites and Social Media. You also acknowledge that video and your photograph may be taken during the competition and may be published on all the Narrabri Pistol Club, NSWAPA, SA or PA all Social media and related media platforms.
15. COVID-19. All competitors, spectators, family or visitors to the National Championships will have to comply with any NSW Government Covid-19 restrictions or requirements in place at the time of the championships.
16.
