OPENING CEREMONY:
The Opening Ceremony will be held at the end of the competition on Friday 16th September 2022. Finger food/BBQ will be provided following the Opening Ceremony on the range at the nominated cost.

LICENCING OF PISTOLS:
All visiting shooters to the ACT with current target pistol licenses in their own State have reciprocal rights while competing in the ACT. Permits or licenses will be checked.

CATERING:
Canteen facilities will be available on Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

Camping facilities including hot showers etc. are available at the range at a cost of \$15.00 per person for the Championships.

AWARDS:
Pistol Australia will provide the following awards:

- i. **Perpetual Trophies:**
Top Gun in each category – Production, Revolver, Standing and Unlimited.
Four Match Big Bore Aggregate in Open, Women's and Junior Individual and Team categories.
- ii. **Plaques:**
1st, 2nd and 3rd in Open, Women's and Junior Four Match Aggregate.
1st, 2nd and 3rd in each category – Production, Revolver, Standing and Unlimited.
- iii. **Brassards:**
1st to 10th in each category – Production, Revolver, Standing and Unlimited.
- iv. **Team Medals:**
1st, 2nd and 3rd Four Match Aggregate Women's and Junior categories.
1st, 2nd and 3rd Open in each category – Production, Revolver, Standing and Unlimited.

GRADE TROPHIES:
The Sporting Shooters Pistol Club ACT will provide grade trophies for the top three (3) places in each grade.

PRACTICE: The range will be open for practice from 9.00am – 3.00pm on Thursday 15th September 2022.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. All resident Australian competitors must be current financial members of Pistol Australia.
2. The Championships will be held over 3 days under IMSSU Rules as adopted by Pistol Australia. Unlimited Full-Scale category will be held as a side match. Persons entering more than four (4) matches must be available for the three days.
All competitors, visitors, and volunteers will comply with the relevant COVID-19 Health requirements in force at the time. If you are feeling unwell, have any symptoms of COVID-19, or have been in contact with someone affected by COVID-19, do not attend the range. The SSPC Pistol Club reserves the right to insist that anyone with these symptoms leaves the premises. Hand sanitizer will be available. Social distancing will apply where applicable.
3. Gun Checks will be supervised by the Jury and will commence at 4.00pm on Practice Day, Thursday 15th September 2022 and also one (1) hour prior to competition on other days.
4. All Competitors should be graded, and grading cards will be requested at Registration.
5. Shooters should be ready at least 10 minutes before their squaddled relay.
6. Shooting will commence at 8.00am each day unless advised otherwise.
7. Shooters or their spotters will be required to stand and paint the targets. Target setters are advised to check the weight of the targets before lifting to ensure weights are within their physical capabilities; and that targets are lifted in the correct manner. It is recommended that gloves be worn when setting targets. Suitable footwear and clothing must be worn on the range. A vehicle will be provided for transport to turkeys and rams.
8. Qualified or suitably experienced persons will accept range duties where indicated in their squadding details.
9. Each State / Territory is eligible to enter the following teams:
 - (a) Open - two (2) person Team in each category – Production, Revolver, Standing and Unlimited.
 - (b) Women's & Junior categories - two (2) person Four Match Aggregate Team.
10. Tied scores will be determined in the following manner:
 - (a) First, second & third place in each category must be decided by shoot-off if scores are equal.
 - (b) Four Match Individual and Team Aggregates decided by reverse count back i.e., total number of rams, then the total number of turkeys etc. If scores are still equal the tie will be broken by a shoot-off of five (5) shots per category.
 - (c) Ties for first, second, and third places in grades will be decided by reverse count and then by shoot-off if still equal.
 - (d) Shoot-off sequence will be as follows:
 - i. Standing – full-scale turkeys at 75m
 - ii. Revolver, Production, Unlimited and Full Scale Unlimited – half scale targets consisting of turkey, pig, chicken, pig, turkey at 200m.
 - (e) Shoot-offs will be in five shot strings and will be exhaustive.
11. The range will be open for practice from 9.00am – 3.00pm on Thursday 15th September 2022.
12. Full jacketed ammunition allowed in revolver only.
13. The competition will be conducted using the relay system and only the daily start time will be given.
14. Pistol licences/permits will be checked at gun check and each day. Licences being renewed will require proof of application.
