OPENING CEREMONY: The Opening Ceremony will be held at the end of competition on Friday 17th September 2021. This will be followed by finger food and a dinner at the range.

LICENCING OF PISTOLS: All visiting shooters to NSW with current target pistol licences/permits in their own State have reciprocal rights while competing in NSW. Licences/Permits will be checked.

CATERING: Canteen facilities will be available on Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

AWARDS:

Pistol Australia will provide the following awards:

i. Perpetual Trophies:

Top Gun in each category - Production, Revolver, Standing and Unlimited
Four Match Big Bore Aggregate in Open, Women's and Junior Individual and Teams' categories

ii. Plaques:

1st, 2nd and 3rd in Open, Women and Junior Four Match Aggregate.
1st, 2nd and 3rd in each category, Production, Revolver, Standing and Unlimited

iii. Brassards:

1st to 10th in each category, Production, Revolver, Standing and Unlimited

iv. Team Medals:

1st, 2nd and 3rd in Four Match Aggregate Women and Junior categories.
1st, 2nd, and 3rd Open in each category, Production, Revolver, Standing and Unlimited

GRADE TROPHIES:

Inverell RSM Pistol Club will provide grade trophies for the top three (3) places in each grade.

PRACTICE: The range will be open for practice from 9.00am – 4.00pm on Thursday 16th September 2021.

CLOTHING: A Nationals shirt will be on display and available to order.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. All resident Australian competitors must be current financial members of Pistol Australia.
2. The Championship will be held over three (3) days under Pistol Australia (IMSSU) Rules. Unlimited Full Scale will be held as a side match. Persons entering more than four (4) matches must be available for the three days.
 - 2a. All competitors, visitors and volunteers will comply with the relevant COVID-19 Health requirements in force at the time. If you are feeling unwell, have any symptoms of COVID-19, or have been in contact with someone affected by COVID-19, do not attend the range. The Inverell RSM Pistol Club reserves the right to insist that anyone with these symptoms leave the premises. Hand sanitizer will be available. Social distancing where applicable. NO shooting mats will be supplied, please bring your own mat.
3. Gun Checks will be supervised by a member of the Jury and will commence at 4.00pm on Practice Day, Thursday 16th September 2021 and one (1) hour prior to competition on other days.
4. All Competitors should be graded, and grading cards will be collected at Registration.
5. Shooters to be ready at least 10 minutes before their squadded relay.
6. Shooting will commence at 8.00am each day unless otherwise advised.
7. Shooters or their spotters will be required to stand and paint the targets. Target setters are advised to check the weight of the targets before lifting to ensure weights are within their physical capabilities; and that targets are lifted in the correct manner. It is recommended that gloves be worn when setting targets. Suitable footwear and clothing must be worn on the range. A vehicle will be provided for transport to the turkeys and rams.
8. Qualified or suitably experienced persons will accept range duties where indicated on their squadding.
9. Each State/Territory is eligible to enter the following teams:
 - (a) Open - two (2) person Team in each of the four categories – Production, Revolver, Standing & Unlimited
 - (b) Women and Junior categories - two (2) person Four Match Aggregate Team
10. Tied scores will be determined in the following manner:
 - (a) The first three places in each category will be decided by shoot-off if scores are equal;
 - (b) Four Match Individual and Team Aggregates decided by reverse count back i.e. total number of rams, then total number of turkeys etc. If scores are still equal the tie will be broken by a shoot-off of five (5) shots per category;
 - (c) Ties for first, second and third places in grades will be decided by reverse count and then by shoot-off if still equal.
 - (d) Shoot-off sequence will be Standing, Revolver, Production, Unlimited and Unlimited Full Scale. Where a competitor is involved in more than one shoot-off in the same category, the first score will count for both shoot-offs.
 - (e) Shoot-off targets will be as follows:
 - i. Standing – full scale turkeys at 150 metres
 - ii. Production, Revolver, Unlimited and Unlimited Full Scale – half scale targets, consisting of turkey, pig, chicken, pig, turkey at 200 metres
 - (f) Shoot-offs will be five (5) shot strings and will be exhaustive.
11. The range will be open for practice from 9:00am to 4.00pm on Thursday 16th September, 2021.
12. Full jacket ammunition allowed in Revolvers only.
13. Pistol licences/permits will be checked at gun check and each day. Licences being renewed will require proof of reapplication.
14. Camping is available on the range – hot showers etc. Need to supply own power and drinking water.
