- 1. An appropriately qualified Judge will be arranged with the NSW APA State Referee Council.
- 2. Where required, Certified Boxes, Weights, Scales and Measuring Equipment will be arranged and used to check all pistols prior to them being used in the competition. Where required by Match rules ammunition will be checked and chronographed.
- 3. Backing Targets are compulsory for all Black Powder; Service Pistol and ISSF matches (except Rapid Fire & Air Pistol).
- 4. New targets will be used where required or requested.
- 5. Two (2) Register Keepers will be provided where required or the approved Cameron system used.
- 6. One (1) copy of the Official signed results Sheets for the competition must be received in the NSW APA Office within three (3) weeks of the competition.
- 7. Competitors will be squadded.

The Pistol Club comply with the Sanction Match requirements. I understand future Sanctioning requests may not be approved if this Competition is not conducted according to the current Sanction Match Criteria.
